Our speaker will be Kristin Alder, a graduate student and teaching fellow in Women's Studies at the University of North Texas. She is currently finishing her thesis on the role of the Women's International League of Peace and Freedom (WILPF) in the development and implementation of United Nations Security Resolution 1325 on Women, War and Security.

In 2010, Kristin was one of twenty women selected to attend a practicum in advocacy at the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women

(CSW) sponsored by WILPF. Kristin returned to the CSW in 2011 as a delegate for WILPF and currently sits on two of WILPF's national committees.

Kristin's topic will be

"Domesticating the UN's Agenda on Women, Peace and Security: the Role of the Women's International League of Peace and Freedom in the Development of the US National Action Plan on UN Security Resolution 1325."
